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## PROGRESSION

- To further education:
  - Level 5 Diploma in Leadership for Health and Social Care and Children and Young People's Services (England)

## COURSE REQUIREMENTS

- Have achieved Maths, English and ICT Level 2 qualifications
- Learners will need to be working, volunteering or on practical placement as they will need to show competence in both knowledge and skills.
- If you have no previous experience, it is recommended that 400 hours be spent in a real work environment.
