COURSE REQUIREMENTS

- Have achieved the Functional Skills Maths and English Level 2 qualifications
- Learners will need to be working, volunteering or on a practical placement
- Learners must be able to gain individual experience in real work environments across the age range from 0-5 years. A minimum of 300 work/placement hours are required during the duration of the course.
