



COURSE CONTENT

- Read and understand text in detail
- Identify the main points and ideas from a written text and suitable responses for it
- Write clearly with the appropriate level of detail
- Use language, format and structure suitable for the purpose and audience
- Write using correct grammar, including the correct and consistent use of tense
- Check that the written work includes accurate punctuation and spelling, and that the meaning is clear
- Plan, take part and make relevant contributions to formal and informal discussions and exchanges with one or more people in a professional manner
- Present information and points of view clearly and in appropriate language to others in your everyday life
